ACBA 2019 YOUTH ACHIEVEMENT CONTEST

PURPOSE

To acknowledge outstanding achievement and leadership by ACBA youth members in the cavy fancy, as measured by activities in organizations and associations, performance on the show table, and achievements in breeding and raising animals.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be current members of the ACBA at the time of entry and participation. Membership status will be confirmed by the ACBA Youth Chair with the ACBA Secretary.

RULES

1. Any ACBA Youth Member is eligible to compete. Attendance at the ACBA Specialty Show is **NOT** necessary.
2. Application must be made from the form provided by the ACBA Youth Committee. These forms are available from the ACBA Youth Chairperson, members of the Youth Committee, and the ACBA Website.
3. Applications are to be completed by the contestant and in their own words. Youth under the age of nine may choose to have some help in filling out the application.
4. Up to five (5) pages, printed on one side only, of information may be submitted by the applicant. These should include information needed to complete the answers. Visual aids may be included within this page limitation.
5. Applications will be judged by district, and age within district; up to 9 yrs., 9-11 yrs., 12-14 yrs. and 15-18 yrs. Age is determined by age on the last day of 2019 ACBA Specialty (March 31, 2019).
6. Winners will be announced at the ACBA Banquet at the ACBA Specialty Show. Contestants need not be present to win.
7. Applications may be submitted in one of the following two ways:

Option 1) Send your original application page (filled out completely) and **THREE** copies of your answers! A current photograph of yourself is optional. If you do include a photograph, please be sure it is of high clarity for reproduction in print publication. There will be a 10-point deduction for incomplete applications.

Option 2) Email your application in a Word document: original application page (filled out completely) and **one** copy of your answers! Also include a current photograph of yourself, if you are submitting a photograph. (these items will need to be scanned and attached to the email).
8. Make sure to sign the application! Failure to have signature will result in a 10 point deduction.

9. Do not place your name on your application other than on the signature sheet! Placing your name on any of your application pages will result in a 10 point deduction. Mailed applications must be postmarked by February 15, 2019, emailed applications must be received by midnight (MST) February 15, 2019.
