Count and Countess must not have reached their 9th birthday by the closing day of the A.C.B.A. specialty convention. All ages are determined by the applicant's age on the closing day of the A.C.B.A. specialty convention.

**Rules**

1. Youth must meet age requirements as listed above.
2. Youth must be a current member in good standing of the A.C.B.A.
3. Each applicant is required to participate in the following activities as part of the royalty contest.

Completed royalty application

Written exam

Breed identification which will include identifying the variety and color.

Equipment identification

Showmanship contest with oral questions presented by judging committee. Questions will be age appropriate and applicant will be required to judge their animal using the current Standard of Perfection guidelines.

4. Count and Countess Applicants will be provided with help in reading the written test if needed.
5. Applicants must be available for all events scheduled. Lateness to any event will be cause for disqualification.
6. The questions for the written test will be taken from the ACBA guidebook, the JACBA publications, current ACBA Judges, and the current Standard of Perfection.
7. The winners will be determined by compiling the scores from the combined events to obtain a total score for each applicant in each division. Awards will be given to the winners as well as first runners up.
8. Winners will be announced at the A.C.B.A. specialty convention banquet.

## **Application Rules**

1. All Applications must be submitted on official ACBA youth royalty forms.
2. Applications are available from the national youth chairperson, the ACBA secretary, your ACBA district representative, the ACBA website, or any member of the youth committee.
3. All applications become the property of the national youth committee and will not be returned.
4. Additional information is limited to one extra sheet of paper double sided, and can include visual aides (photos, drawings, pictures, dimensional sketches, etc.) There will be a 15 point deduction for each extra sheet over the allotted amount of pages.
5. Four (4) copies of your completed application and a recent school photo must accompany your applications. Failure to do so will result in a 20 point deduction on your application.
6. All applications must be a postmarked by **March 10, 2010**
7. All applications received with postmarks after **March 10, 2010** will be destroyed and notification sent to the applicant.
