ACBA 2022 YOUTH EDUCATIONAL CONTEST

PURPOSE

To acknowledge excellence among ACBA youth members who create exhibits that show some aspect of the cavy fancy. These exhibits must be placed on view at the 2022 ACBA Specialty Show.

RULES

1. Any ACBA youth member is eligible to compete. Attendance at the ACBA Specialty Show is **NOT** necessary.
2. Pre-entry is required. Please mail this form by March 27th, 2022
3. Exhibits are **NOT** sent at this time but are brought to the ACBA Specialty Show and must be checked in by to 9am Saturday.
4. Exhibits must be informational or promotional of cavies or include a cavy as part of their design.
5. A contestant may enter as many classes as they choose but may submit only one entry per class.
6. Each entry must be the work of the contestant and must have been completed in the 12 months prior to the ACBA Specialty Show.
7. All entries must be displayed in the designated area at the ACBA Specialty Show.
8. All entries will receive ribbons (Blue=Excellent, Red=Very Good, White=Good). Top entries in each category will be reevaluated to determine class winners.
9. Your name and age should be on the back of your exhibit. You or someone you designate must pick up exhibits before ***2pm Sunday, May 8th, 2022.** Be sure your exhibit comes with instructions as to the disposition of your exhibit at the end of Specialty. An attempt will be made to return any unclaimed exhibits through your ACBA District Director. Otherwise unclaimed exhibits will be destroyed at the end of Specialty.

Divisions

Exhibitors will enter the class listed below, and based upon age, exhibit in one of the three age divisions for EACH CLASS. For example, there will be three Art – Drawing classes (Junior, Intermediate, Senior) that will each have a Best of Class Award. These three class winners, along with the three class winners in Art – Painting and Art – Sculpture or Carving will compete for the National Winner in the Art Group.

Mailed application form and Youth specialty contest entry form must be postmarked by March 27th, 2022. Forms postmarked after March 27th, 2022 will be returned thus notifying applicant to not bring entry to ACBA Specialty.
